
CVE Logo Usage Guidelines

CVE is a trademark [™] and the CVE logo is a registered trademark [®] of the <u>Common Vulnerabilities and</u> Exposures (CVE™) Program. Guidelines for using the CVE logo are included below.

1. Standard Logo

The official version of the CVE logo is below. The [®] trademark symbol MUST always be visible and readable in any displays of the CVE logo. It MUST NOT be removed or obfuscated.



2. Logo Colors

CMYK and RGB colors for the official version of the CVE logo are indicated below.

3. Logo Placement

Always ensure that there is sufficient clear space around the logo.


4. Word Mark

CVE is a word mark. The trademark symbol ™ MUST always be visible and readable when the CVE wordmark is introduced in content as shown below, with one exception: the trademark symbol SHOULD NOT be included in the syntax of a CVE Identifier (CVE ID).

5. One-Color Logo

In certain instances, such as printing, the CVE logo may need to be reproduced using only a single color. When this occurs, the logo symbol and words, or logo symbol only, SHOULD BE reproduced using the printing conventions of a light color type on a dark background or a dark color type on a light background. The outline of the logo symbol and words or logo symbol SHOULD BE clearly distinguishable from the background color.



6. Improper Logo Usage

DO NOT make any changes or modifications to the logo shape or colors for any reason.
